

- Do not allow staff members with a history of international travel to come to work for 14 days.
- Do not allow staff members that are sick to come to work.
- Minimize the number of staff that are working at once
- Clean and sanitize frequently
- Encourage debit and credit transactions to reduce the exchange of cash.

We cannot stress enough the importance of social distancing and sanitization for the safety of your customers, staff and ultimately our community members and children. 


## 6. ELECTION 2020
